## Committed to Supporting Our Communities

At AstraZeneca, we strive to make a meaningful difference in people's lives. Though we continually invest in developing new, effective prescription medications and treatments for diseases, we know that a healthier world cannot come from medicines alone. We believe true progress in solving current healthcare challenges lies in the connections made by all those working to improve patient health. Every day, AstraZeneca works hard to improve health in communities throughout the U.S. In 2010 alone, AstraZeneca donated over \$21 million to nonprofit organizations for programs and projects aimed primarily at improving health across the U.S.<sup>2</sup>

## Creating Access to Affordable Medicines

We recognize that no matter how effective our medicines, they do little good if people do not have access to them, cannot afford them, or do not fully understand how to take them. AstraZeneca has introduced several programs to address these concerns.

Our AZ&Me™ Prescription Savings programs help qualified patients access the AstraZeneca medicines they need, while providing them with information that can help them stay healthy. In 2010, we helped over 545,000 patients fill 10.6 million prescriptions through our patient assistance programs, resulting in \$947 million of savings to patients in the U.S. This represents an 18 percent increase over 2009 in the number of patients who received our assistance.<sup>3</sup>

AstraZeneca supports the United Way of Delaware-led "Healthy Delawareans Today & Tomorrow" (HDTT) initiative, a coalition of organizations dedicated to increasing awareness and visibility of free and low-cost healthcare services for uninsured Delawareans. More than 38,000 uninsured Delawareans have been linked to free or low cost health services since 2007.<sup>4</sup> AstraZeneca has contributed more than \$2.6 million in support of HDTT and related programs since the start of HDTT in 2007.<sup>5</sup>

## AstraZeneca Healthcare Foundation

The Foundation was established in 1993 as a Delaware not-for-profit corporation and 501(c)(3) entity organized for charitable purposes. The mission of the Foundation is to promote public awareness of healthcare issues and public education of medical knowledge; and to support qualified exempt organizations consistent with its charitable purpose.

The Foundation's signature program, *Connections for Cardiovascular Health*<sup>SM</sup>, awards Foundation grants of \$150,000 and up to U.S.-based, nonprofit organizations that are doing innovative work in the field of cardiovascular health in the U.S. In 2010, over \$2.5 million in Foundation grants were awarded to 14 nonprofit organizations across the U.S. dedicated to improving cardiovascular health in local communities. The program was established in 2009 through a charitable contribution of \$25 million from AstraZeneca.

The AstraZeneca HealthCare Foundation is a tax-exempt entity organized under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and not part of the commercial entity, AstraZeneca Pharmaceuticals LP.

## Protecting our Environment

The environmental agenda for 2010 centered on reducing the energy we use and the waste we create at the source. Employee efforts paid off by reducing our waste generated by 35 percent when compared to 2009. We recognized the need to manage the waste in a more eco-friendly manner and reduced what we sent to landfill by 77 percent over 2009.

In 2010, we continued our commitment to a more efficient use of energy. We did this by taking a series of measures designed to reduce the U.S. energy use across our buildings; by year's end, we had achieved a 5 percent reduction over prior the year. Our supply sites in Westborough and Newark were once again among the first pharmaceutical manufacturing facilities to receive the 2010 EPA Energy Star certification, in addition to our recertification of buildings at our Wilmington, DE site.

## Encouraging Employee Wellness

AstraZeneca believes creating a safe work environment for our employees that promotes healthy living and celebrates diversity is an essential obligation of being a responsible company. With more than a dozen programs designed to promote employee health, AstraZeneca was one of only three pharmaceutical companies named a 2009 "Best Employer for Healthy Lifestyles" at the Gold level by the National Business Group on Health. Chief among our health-oriented programs is MedCheck, an on-site wellness program offered at all but one of our U.S. sites.

In 2010, AstraZeneca was awarded the American Heart Association's Start! Fit Friendly Company Platinum Award for our emphasis on getting our employees moving in annual 5K walks/runs, and along indoor and outdoor walking trails. We were also named the top Bike Friendly Business in Delaware during 2010. Additionally, we have been accredited with the CEO Cancer Gold Standard since 2006, which recognizes our disciplined focus on the prevention and early detection of cancer.
